2019 OFF TO A GREAT START FOR LUCKY DUNFERMLINE BINGO PLAYER WHO CALLED 'HOUSE' ON £50,000 JACKPOT

2019 is off to a great start for lucky local bingo player Sylvia Cuthbertson, who saw all her numbers come up at Carlton Bingo Dunfermline on the **National Bingo Game**, scooping a whopping Jackpot prize of £50,000.

Sylvia, 49, was playing bingo on Saturday 22nd December at Carlton Bingo Dunfermline when her regular bingo session, her last before Christmas, took an unexpected and exciting turn: she called 'house' on the **National Bingo Game**. The prospect of a Christmas win felt great and Sylvia was waiting to have her claim and the value of the Club Prize confirmed. It was only when the bingo caller confirmed the claim and the £50,000 jackpot Prize that Sylvia realised the size of her win, she said "I didn't realise I had won the Jackpot and it was a shock, but once it was confirmed I felt elated and quite emotional."

Sylvia was introduced to bingo by her Mum and stepfather when she was 18 and first played at Carlton Bingo's previous Dunfermline club, the Alhambra in Canmore Street, and has been a regular player ever since, attending once or twice a week. Usually Sylvia likes to attend on her own, as it gets her out of the house and allows her time to think, though occasionally her sister joins her and every month she meets up with old work mates for a game and catch-up: working fulltime for a hotel linen and laundry service Sylvia said she appreciates the opportunity for a little 'me' time at bingo.

Speaking a few days after her win Sylvia said, "It's only just starting to sink in: neither my husband nor me could quite believe it at first. We don't have any plans at present, though I am sure we will spend some of it on the house, doing a bit of redecorating, and on the garden. Commenting on bingo Sylvia said, "You should have a go, you never know! Anyone can win and it's not just for old folks; there are all ages playing and a lot of young people too." /More
