A Scottish city has been hailed as Britain's fourth luckiest location after players across 4 Glasgow clubs shouted 'house' on 54 National Bingo Game wins in 2013!

The National Bingo Game Association (NBGA) has identified the top 10 Luckiest Towns by collating all National Bingo Game wins and sorting into the most wins in each town.

Lucky souls at Mecca Bingo clubs in The Forge Centre, Glasgow Quay and Drumchapel and Carlton Bingo, Partick placed Glasgow fourth in the table even after the total wins were averaged out between the clubs. Five extremely happy Glaswegian bingo players scooped up £25,000 wins.

The title of Britain's luckiest town went to Blackpool which celebrated 22 big winners at Mecca Bingo, Blackpool. Closely behind was Stockton-On-Tees in second place and Newport in third.

NBGA Chief Executive Miles Baron said: 'We are delighted to announce that there have been 946 National Bingo Game big winners over the last 12 months, winning over £9 million between them but we'll be beating these figures for 2014 with the launch of a new Jackpot!

National Bingo Game Fast Facts

- Total prize money distributed to date is over £1BILLION!
- The National Bingo Game is the UK's second largest computer controlled game in the UK, the national lottery being the largest.
- The biggest bingo win ever was on 23 March 2008, when Soraya Lowell from Motherwell, North Lanarkshire scooped GBP £1,167,795, while playing The National Game at Club 3000 in Coatbridge.
- Between 120 - 200 clubs link together to play the National Game twice a day, every day, except Christmas day.
- Over three million people play bingo regularly in the UK (at least twice a week).

- A night out at the bingo can cost as little as £15-25 each, including game books, duty, food and drink.
- Most common reasons for playing bingo are because it's fun, it offers companionship and the chance to socialise as well as winning big money.
- Celebrities love bingo! Catherine Zeta Jones can thank bingo for her career after her dad won enough to afford to send her to theatre school; other celebrity fans include: Denise Van Outen, Scott Mills and President Barrack Obama's step-mother!
- A number of celebrities also started their careers in bingo calling including Simon from boy band Blue, EastEnder's Shane Richie, Russell Crowe and Kian from West Life.
